Genesis 22

"Take your son..."

Features of this chapter:

- 1. Written in a very SIMPLE style: repetitious and grave.
- 2. Shows that the climax of Abraham's life is a TEST.
- 3. Very SYMBOLIC of the sacrifice of Jesus.

Things to learn from this passage:

- 1. God's tests on his children happen after he gives his greatest BLESSINGS.
- 2. God TESTS and God PROVIDES.
- 3. God is most honored by us when we submit to his PROVIDENCE.
- 4. We are greatly rewarded by OBEDIENCE to God's word.

- 2. The future WIFE of Isaac.
