This large family is given to Jacob by God, and so it is part of the fulfillment of God's promise to Jacob at Bethel. These 11 boys will grow up to be the heads of the nation of Israel. Also, as many of the stories of Genesis do, these births foreshadow the coming victory of Joseph in redeeming his brothers, and they point further out to a son - Jesus - who would be supernaturally born to redeem all the family of God.
